

### **WOMEN'S CLUB QUARTERAUCTION - NOV. 16**

### WHAT IS A QUARTER AUCTION AND HOW DOES IT WORK?

- A quarter auction is designed as a fund raiser for charity. In our case, the monies will contribute to the amount we donate to multiple charities at the end of the season.
- Each participant can purchase a numbered paddle for \$3 or 2 for \$5. A corresponding number is put into a container for the drawings.
- ▶ Make sure you have brought rolls of quarters or purchase rolls of quarters prior to the beginning of the event.
- Vendors will be set up around the room to display their products and you may purchase items cash and carry. They rely on these purchases to supplement the donations they have made.
- Food and soft drinks will be available for purchase throughout the evening.
- Seats are available first come, first served. Each table will have a container in the middle of the table for your quarter bids.
- When the auction begins, the MCs will explain the rules to ensure everyone is clear as to how the auction is run.
- ➤ Someone will offer an item for bid and ask that those interested in bidding should put quarters (number requested 1, 2, or 3 for each paddle) in the container and raise the paddles. After all monies are collected, a number is drawn. If the paddle is held up as a bid then the person with the paddle wins the product. If that number has not been raised then another number is drawn until a winner occurs. The number of quarters requested is based on the value of the product. The higher the cost, the more quarters requested. All numbers are returned to the container so it is possible to win multiple times. Remember if you have multiple paddles you must put in multiples of the requested quarters to bid. You may choose to only raise one paddle but if the other paddle's number is drawn you will not be eligible to win with that number.
- ➤ This event has become very popular around the area. Products auctioned will be a variety that will appeal to everyone at some time, both male and female.
- ▶ If successful, this event will be repeated at a later date. Please support your Women's Club. Thank you.

- The seawall on Hole #10 is completed; concrete repair and tee repair need to be completed. No date has been set for the sodding of #10 Tee box. Davey will do the work.
- The company "Solitude" has been hired to check the algae growth in the lakes. Chemicals have been added but can only be repeated every two weeks. "Solitude" checks every 30 days, and comes when needed.
- Julie will talk with Joshua Tree concerning residents' complaints about mowers going too fast and leaving grass dug up by mowers' tires. Julie will also discuss the trimming of shrubs along the walking paths.

### Clubhouse

 Another similar machine has been ordered to replace the missing machine in the exercise room. It will be a "3 stack" machine.

### Discussions

- Estate properties bought by ELS, when sold, will follow the Rules and Regulations already in place for leased land properties.
- ELS has purchased 11 Estate properties and has sold none of the homes. ELS does not want to be in the rental business so eventually will sell the homes.
- No P4 prospectuses have been used on any properties in Pine Lakes.

- Pine Lakes is a "market community" and lot leases are not assumable. New owners are taken to "market rent" at the time of lease signing.
- The late rent payment fee will be the same; \$75.
- Some residents have concerns about Encore RV Park and it being annexed to Pine Lakes. Julie said the RV section of ELS is a separate division with their own property managers, etc. and there are no plans to make it a part of Pine Lakes. Julie said she would contact Corporate and ask for a letter stating this fact.

### LINE DANCING






