HOA II BOARD

Gary Nicolini, President

This is what your HOAII has been working on: THE CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT ARRANGEMENT.

First, Owners of Pine Lakes Leased Land Manufactured Homes entered into 3 Agreements, by signing these with ELS. Owners Purchased their Home.

- These Agreements are, A Prospectus, The Lease Agreement and Rules referred to from the Prospectus (Covered by Florida Statute 723) NOTE THAT NO HOA PERSON is with any owners at the time of "CLOSING", however,
- The Homeowner expects the land owner to uphold the terms of these 3 agreements.
- The Prospectus may be updated and changed by MUTUAL consent. Meaning BOTH SIDES OF THIS "CONTRACT" MUST AGREE TO CHANGES NOT LISTED as changeable in the Prospectus.
- ELS upper management (not Local) did not uphold the terms of these agreements by making changes without mutual agreement with Homeowner.
- So, if homeowner believes agreements have been violated, the homeowner has the right to individually bring this to a court of law for ruling.

This is essential for emergency services, visitors & package deliveries.



₩ With the exception of Fed-Ex, Amazon, UPS, and USPS,

residents must call the gate to inform them of all visitors, and contractors coming to their home.

• FL Ch 723 provides for the method for which the HOA, on behalf of all owners, can bring action ultimately as well to court.

IN AUGUST

- ELS SENT A 90 DAY NOTICE OF A COPY OF PROSPECTUS AND RULES CHANGES TO EACH LEASED LAND OWNER (Except 18...which many believe ELS is managing against Fl Ch 723)
- THE FEDERATION OF MANUFACTURED HOMEOWNERS (FMO) AND NETWORKING FOR PROGRESS (NFP) notified ELS communities that this was a multi park ELS action

IN SEPTEMBER

- HOAII representatives discussed ELS ACTIONS IN OCTOBER
- HOAII representatives met with Attorney IN NOVEMBER
- HOAII FILED A NOTICE OF OBJECTION TO ELS ABOUT THESE CHANGES IN DECEMBER
- HOAII BEGAN COLLECTING SIGNATURES TO GET 50% PLUS 1 LEASED LAND MANUFACTURED HOMEOWNERS IN PINE LAKES TO AGREE TO ALLOW A STATUTORY COMMITTEE NEGOTIATE WITH ELS ON THESE CHANGES.
- ELS AGREED TO NOT IMPLEMENT CHANGES FOR JAN 1, 2024 LEASED LAND PAYMENTS

IN JANUARY

- Statutory committee met to discuss issue
- Met with Attorney.
- NOTE: Please abide by the Pine Lakes speed
 limit of 20mph and try to be aware of
 walkers and bikers when driving car/truck/
 golf cart to avoid accidents.



IN FEBRUARY

- HOAII Again requests ELS to meet MARCH 27 (MEETING required by 723 BEFORE filing for mediation)
- ELS notifies HOAII of meeting date.
- HOAII met with ELS representatives, INCLUDING ELS DISTRICT VICE PRESIDENT OUT OF TAMPA OFFICE
- Because it is known via FMO and NFP that multiple ELS Communities got the same type notice and are following the same direction Pine Lakes is, HOAII ASKED ELS TO AGAIN NOT IMPLEMENT CHANGES until one any of the ELS communities gets a Court Decision.
- TO DATE THERE ARE NO KNOWN COURT DECISIONS FROM ANY OTHER ELS COMMUNITIES.
- ELS, AT THIS MEETING REFUSED THIS HOAII OFFER TO WAIT.
- SO, THE MEETING ENDED AT IMPASSE IN APRIL
- HOAII with Attorney filed for Mediation per Fl Ch 723 statutes.
- Attorney files papers per Fl Ch 723 with DBPR
- AGAIN, NO MEDIATION DATE HAS BEEN SET, TO DATE August 13th.

IN MAY

• ELS PLACED NOTICES IN CLUBHOUSE THAT THEY WILL NOT ACCEPT CHECKS FOR JULY 1 PAYMENT

IN JUNE

- June 21st, Attorney calls for meeting with ELS, and also calls for 3 other communities HE represents, all who have same issue, to meet the same day, in Pine Lakes.
- ELS MAKES NO DECISION AGAIN WITH PINE LAKES, BUT STATES IT WILL REVIEW THE CHANGES.
- IT IS UNKNOWN WHAT ELS AND ATTORNEY DID WITH OTHER COMMUNITIES.
- ELS HAS RETURNED CHECK PAYMENTS TO HOMEOWNERS, DEMANDING HOMEOWNER PAY BY PORTAL

In order for HOAII to move to court action, mediation must occur and result in no agreement, or in other words, mediation results at no action or impasse. AS THIS TIMELINE SHOWS, YOUR HOAII HAS BEEN WORKING FOR YOU AND HAVE NOT BEEN THE CAUSE OF ANY DELAYS IN THE PROCESS.

- ELS'S ACTIONS AND INACTIONS HAVE CAUSED ALL TO COMPLY WITH A DECISION ON PAYMENT THAT ELS DID NOT MAKE MUTUALLY WITH THE HOMEOWNER
- REGARDLESS IF SOME THINK HOMEOWNERS NEED TO JUST "SUCK IT UP" AND PAY AS ELS WANTS, THE ACCUSATION OF ONE SIDE CHANGING A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT MUST BE RESOLVED, but until then we must follow the process until resolve.
- However, until a court of law makes a ruling, ELS will use other parts of the agreement to evict a homeowner for non-payment.



- **September 11 Patriot Day** officially known as National Day of Service and Remembrance, is observed every Sept. 11th in honor of the individuals who lost their lives as a result of terrorist attacks on Sept. 11, 2001.
- September 18 Air Force Birthday The official Air Force Birthday is recognized as Sept. 18, 1947, the date of the passage of the National Security Act of 1947. That legislation created what would later become to known as the United States Department of Defense. This established the United States Air Force as a separate branch of military service.

Barbara Patton – U.S. Navy Hospital Mate 2 (HM2) [Truly a Renaissance Woman]

Born in 1937 in Pontiac Michigan, adopted by Lois and Pearl. She has written a book about her childhood, available on Amazon – Warm Tears and Cold Rutabaga Don't Mix. I've read it – unimaginable! She has a near photographic memory, so schoolwork was easy. Social skills were lacking, but she persevered, graduating in 1955. She started working for Michigan Bell and acquired a few friends. One of those friends thought she should join the military to develop some personal discipline. She poo-pooed the idea until they bet her \$100 she wouldn't join.

On her way to a New Year's Eve party in 1957, dressed to the nines, she passed by a Navy recruiting office that was open. She went in and told the recruiter she wanted to join the Navy (I mean who didn't need \$100?). The recruiter eyeballed her all dolled up for a party and said, "No you don't." She convinced him to give her an application and she joined, entering the service on July 1, 1958. Michigan Bell granted her a three-year military leave of absence.

Her first assignment was to assure she and 11 other new female recruits arrived in Baimbridge, MD for recruit training. At Baimbridge she was assigned as the Recruit Chief Petty Officer (RCPO)for Company 30, composed of 40 young women. She became friends with the RCPO

of Company 31. The two of them broke lots of rules, like patent leather shoes and leaving base with a borrowed motor pool station wagon to go to DC for a day. Even so, they were both awarded for outstanding leadership.

While serving at her next training station in Waukegan, Illinois, she received a letter from Michigan Bell, informing her of their policy to provide a check for three months salary for volunteering to serve her country. She took that unexpected check and bought herself a '53 Dodge Cornet convertible. As this tour was winding down, she was offered a six month special assignment in Naval Intelligence which would permit her to choose her next duty station. She accepted.

After completing that special assignment, she was assigned to Camp Pendleton, CA, her choice. She worked in Medical and Psych wards there, earning her stripes as a hospital corpsman 3rd class, then 2nd class. She saved the life of the Admiral's wife during this assignment.

She left the Navy in 1961 after serving three years, turning down the opportunity to get a college degree from Michigan State fully funded by the Navy. You will have to read her book to see why she made this decision. It involved love.

She went back to work for Michigan Bell in a management position and remained there until retiring with 35 years of service. Her distinguished career included overcoming prejudices at every turn. She was immersed in the breakup of the Bells seeing that regional service was not interrupted as the process evolved into today's system.

She has been married twice and has three stepsons and two stepdaughters as a result. She and Tom, her second husband (now deceased), moved to Pine Lakes in 1991 where she served on all the community activities' boards except the Men's Club and the Women's Club. She currently lives on Frenchman's Court with a stepdaughter, Tondah, and Tondah's cat, Lulu. She enjoys singing, acting in plays, and writing. She is especially fond of writing children's books.




