Welcome to our new section "Spotlight on Our Veterans" – created and written by Denny Miner. In each edition of the Whispering Pines, Denny will highlight one of our members for the community to get to know better.

Chief Joseph F. Landry

Born 1929 in Pawtucket, Rhode Island – First born of eleven, six sisters and four brothers.

Graduated from High School in 1947 and joined the US Navy. He trained for 3 years in a hospital in the Great Lakes. Most of Joe's career was spent working with radiology equipment, either taking X-rays or fixing the machines.

- He got married in November 1950. His son, Dennis (not me), was born in 1953 and his daughter, Colleen, was born in 1955. In June of 1956 his son, Brian, was born. Patrick, 1961. Kevin, 1964. Michael, 1970.
- As you might expect, he was assigned to a variety of ships during his career. In 1955 Joe was assigned to three different MSTS (Military Sea and Transport Service) ships in the Mediterranean. He made port in Italy, Greece, Turkey, Libya, Morocco, England, and Germany during this tour of duty.
- In 1966 he was assigned to the Marines in DaNang, Vietnam, where he worked in a field hospital in Hue. He was promoted to Chief, E7, during this tour. After this tour he was assigned to Camp Pendleton in Oceanside, California and finally to Camp Twentynine Palms (Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center) in California (still the world's largest Marine Corps training base) as the Medical Supply Chief. From there he retired and moved to Indiana where he worked for Bethlehem Steel in their hospital clinic for 22 years.
- Bethlehem Steel hired him as a manager of the clinic. He didn't like that much and when the Xray technician left, he took that job medical machine technologist for the entire department.
- Joe moved into Pine Lakes in 1993 when the community still had gravel roads. He still proudly wears his uniform whenever called upon. He led the Navy's group of veterans in the 2023 Veterans' Day ceremony here in Pine Lakes.
- When asked about some old memories, Joe spoke of a Naval Medical Officer who was his Commander on the USS Yosemite. Fifteen years later Joe served under him again at a different command post. The unusual thing about this was that the Commander remembered him! He also recalled a Hurricane in 1938 (he was 9 years old) when he had to walk home from school. The wind blew down his tree. His tree? The one he had planted and cared for all by himself.






