• If Betty has provided her phone number, an asterisk appears after John's phone number. To then locate Betty's number, look in the back half of the book in the cul-desac listings.

#### Important Dates in Military History -

National Salute to Veteran Patients – week of February 12 - The National Salute To Veteran Patients pays tribute to just under 100,000 patients a day that receive medical treatment in VA medical facilities as well as the nine million U.S. veterans who get care every year.

Coast Guard Reserve Birthday – February 19 - Officially set-up in the late 1930s as a "civilian reserve" operation, it was non-military in nature. The Coast Guard Reserve Act of 1939 was the earliest incarnation. The Reserve soon evolved into something much greater than the original authors of the law had envisioned.

\*\* Have you heard of the **Brick Program?** Our brick program allows U.S. Military veterans and their families to honor their service by purchasing a brick, which is placed in the Veteran's Memorial (in front of the clubhouse). 

#### "SPOTLIGHT ON OUR VETERANS"

Denny Miner



Born 1936 in Johnsonburg, NJ. Has one brother, Joe, a Navy vet. He married Jean in 1975 and they have two children, a son, Billy, and a daughter, Connie. Billy has been in the Air Force for 29 years and Connie is a very special government employee helping veterans with suicidal tendencies. Bob and Jean are very proud of them.

Graduated from High School in 1954. Wasn't sure what he wanted to do but saw that famous sign "Uncle Sam wants YOU" one day when he had gone for mail and decided to check out the opportunities offered by all the services. The Air Force looked the best, so he signed up in 1955.

Testing results led to his career field as an Air Policeman. He was sent to Parks Air Force Base (AFB) in California for 16 weeks of unarmed defense training. After graduating 25th out of 87, he received orders to report to Burtonwood, England following 10 days leave at MacGuire AFB (New Jersey). He recalled his flight over the Atlantic - first stopping in the Azores then Newfoundland. A particular memory of the flight was when the aircraft banked to approach the airport, he saw all the bombed-out buildings from WWII and thought "it looks like a warzone." It was only 10 years after the end of the war.

His assignment at Burtonwood was as a mobile-patrol airman, guarding the B-50 aircraft on the flight line. His unit served alongside and supported the Royal Air Force (RAF). He remembers being selected for the color guard. They would use white shoe polish on their white hats, which turned out to be a bad idea – it rains a lot in England.

During his tour there, he was assigned to work with a German shepherd dog, Bucky. He enjoyed that work. It was not unusual to fly to France or Germany to pick up prisoners and process them out of country back to the states. To acquire his international driver's license, he was required to drive every vehicle on post before driving outside the base. "All that left hand stuff was tricky."



He continued to run this successful event for 16 years!

During one of those events, he was encouraged to look into work at the M&M plant in Hackettstown, not far from his home. He did so and ended up working there for 33 and half years. He started as a laborer in the cocoa melting room and progressed to supervisor of maintenance. Mr. Mars personally met with him and asked if he would organize a Las Vegas night for the company. 
His second special memory is the Honor Flight which he recently took. He just cannot say enough good things about this very special experience offered to military veterans.
