Our annual meeting will be held at 7:00 pm on Monday, February 9, 2026, in the Clubhouse Ballroom during which the election of Directors will be held (check in for voting opens at 6:30 pm). Detailed information about the Annual Meeting was included in the packet delivered to you in early January. Thirty percent (30%) of all Association Members (a "quorum") must be present, in person or by proxy, at the meeting, for the business to be conducted. Therefore, it is important to return the Proxy included in that packet to Election Coordinator DeDe LaBelle prior to the meeting. Alternatively, if you wish to vote in person at the meeting, please check in at the meeting and receive your paper ballot for voting.



As of the writing of this article, our Board will have only four members remaining in office or being voted on at the Annual Meeting, one member short of the five needed for a full Board. If you would be willing to serve on the Board, please attend the Annual Meeting and use the write-in spot on the ballot. You will be asked to speak briefly about yourself and any experience that may be beneficial as a Board Member. If there are still only four members after the Annual Meeting, it is not too late. The Board has the authority to appoint a candidate to the Board during the year.







## "SPOTLIGHT ON OUR VETERANS"

**George Hampson**

**Lance Corporal USMC Reserves**

**W**ithout becoming a Pro, George is the first person I have met who essentially made his love of music a way of making a living. Christmas time was the perfect time to meet George and get his story – The Little Drummer Boy.



In 1949 at the age of 13, George and a few of his friends formed a band. He was the drummer. He didn't tell me, but I bet he and his buddies played more than a few times for their classmates in high school. He graduated in 1955. He and few of his pals decided to join the service. He selected the Marine Reserves. His recruiter identified him as a candidate for the USMC band and guided him accordingly.

Basic training at Camp Lejeune was a bit different. Because he was in the reserves, his basic training was crammed into two weeks. He went through basic infantry training, but he also spent time rehearsing with the band. He had dug out all his remaining military awards and certificates prior to our get together. Sure enough, there was the sharpshooter badge. He qualified with the M1 Garand rifle during his two weeks in basic. George remembered the traumatic day when one of his fellow recruits was killed on the range by a ricochet bullet.

Since Dress Blues were required to perform at certain military events, George acquired a set. He recalled having performed at several military funerals and other formal military events, including parades. After serving eight years of monthly meetings and 2 weeks summer training exercises, he was honorably discharged in 1963 as a Lance Corporal.

George was born in Providence, RI on Thanksgiving Day, 1936, to Florence and Leroy. He had one sister and one brother. His sister's husband had been a tail gunner during WWII. George met Patricia, a Registered Nurse, and married her in 1961. They had one daughter who became a teacher. She honored him with two grandchildren, one boy and one girl. He noted, with a twinkle in his eye, that the granddaughter had become an engineer.

He worked days for a utility company in Pawtucket, RI and performed at regular night paying gigs as a drummer. He liked playing Dixieland Jazz. Some of the gigs that he had worked on in the Marine Reserves had requested that type of music. He loved it. If you recall, the Beatles were big in the 60s and that type of music was very popular among the younger generation. That worked to George's advantage in that he took up teaching music to those aspiring young folks. "I had as many as 48 paying students at one time," said with a big smile.

He and Pat were married for 53 years. They purchased a home here in Pine Lakes when he was only 52. Pine Lakes were in the very rudimentary stage of development at that time. He said it was a jungle. All the Cul-de-Sacs were "cut in" dirt roads. There was a young lady in the sales department who rented the home from George for 13 years. Fortunately, she took very good care of the home. He and Pat moved into that home circa 2001 and enjoyed their time together until her passing in 2014. George worked at the gate for 10 years.

George has a lady friend, Sandra. They have a cruise planned. He used to enjoy bicycle riding, but the old hips and knees have ended that. "I am the last of the original living occupants in Broken Woods." Thinks he might start attending the Veterans Association meetings.

So acrobatic is the shot-making that it can make your heart burp.

Tennis has such a swelling TV audience that ESPN usually outbids The Tennis Channel to broadcast the Majors in real time--even in Australia when the starting time can precede sunrise on the East Coast.

That is why a friend who once played all sports and has never held a tennis ball says he watches tennis year-round "because it is so exciting". For him and for many others the AO now is must-watch TV.

The Majors demand more. In other tournaments all players need to win two out of three sets to win one match. In Majors the men only must win three of five possible sets to win just one match--a sunbaked imposition on bodies and brains.

Total prize money for the AO is \$75m. Each men's and women's singles champion collect \$2.79m while the runners-up are rewarded \$1.44m. Even a first-round loser can pack his/her suitcase with \$110,000 in prize money. (Sign me up!)

The women's final is Saturday Jan. 31 on both ESPN and later The Tennis Channel, and the men's final is Sunday Feb. 1

So, grab your popcorn. BE THERE!






