## C.E.R.T.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO ALL RESIDENTS

Lee County E.O.C. (Emergency Operations Center) and North Fort Myers Fire Department has asked the Pine Lakes C.E.R.T. team to help them identify residents that choose to stay in place when a Mandatory Evacuation Order has been issued by Florida State officials for manufactured homes (Pine Lakes). The Mandatory Evacuation Order is usually ordered when high winds are expected as with a hurricane, tornado, or a storm surge.

Our solution is to have *residents who choose to stay in place* complete a short form that can be obtained at the Gate House or concierge desk and deposit it in the Emergency Evacuation Box located on the exit side of the Gate House wall. This information may be used by First Responders to expedite rescue response time after a disaster.

Please plan ahead. If evacuation is ordered, complete and deposit the form as soon as you make your decision to stay. Thank you, Mike Gloss C.E.R.T.

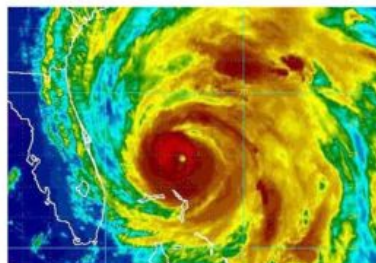

Residents are reminded that the Lake Fairways exercise room IS available for use by Pine Lakes residents. A new exercise bicycle was delivered and will be available when construction is completed.

Observations and opinions of not only P. L. tennis playing residents but those "outside" players as well, have generally stated and continue to say that they truly enjoy the playing experience, camaraderie (as mentioned), networking and particularly the playing format that has evolved to date.

With all that's been stated, we continue to encourage additional resident and non-resident players to our get-togethers from 9:00 – 10:30 A.M., Monday through Friday. And most notably, the P.L. Summer Program started on May 1st and runs through October 15th. Please join us or just come out to the courts during stated times and days to see for yourself. 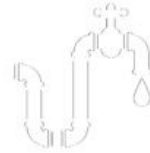
