The Lee County Hearing Examiner held the public meeting concerning the rezoning of the French Property on December 1 and 2. I would like to thank all the Pine Lakes homeowners who showed up. Most of the questions asked were concise and to the point. We in Pine Lakes do not want the joining of the two properties. I believe that the Hearing Examiner understood our point and will take that into consideration when she makes her ruling. The examiner said that the ruling could take up to thirty days before it is issued. After the ruling is made, the last chance we have to make our case will be before the Board of County Commissioners. That meeting will be set after the ruling is issued.

The annual meeting of the Board of Directors will be held on January 17 at 7:00 pm in the Ballroom. The election of Board members will take place at this meeting. There are five Board memberships up for election this year. I urge you to pay your dues and come out and vote at the meeting. There will also be a vote of the membership to transfer monies to the legal account.

The past year has been a long and stressful one for the Officers and the Board. The HEX hearing is not the end of the ongoing struggle with ELS over the French Creek expansion question. There are still many questions that will need to be answered before the entire process is over. I ask that everyone continue to stay involved and up to date on the process as we move forward.

The Board cannot stress enough the importance of everyone paying their dues. Florida State Statue 723 that governs the requirements of HOA’s states that a homeowner has an obligation to pay their dues. Webster’s Dictionary states that an obligation is “an act or course of action to which a person is morally, or duty bound.” While the board does not take the paying of dues as a moral obligation, it should be considered a duty.

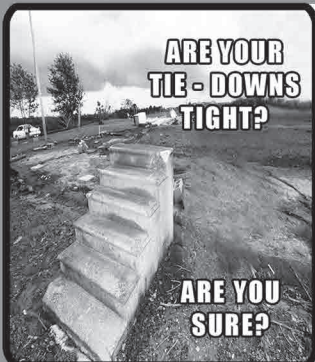

TEXAS HOLD-EM

On behalf of the Texas Hold-em Committee, I would like to thank the Men's Club Board for continuing to sponsor us.

The Texas Hold-em Committee would like to invite all the male and female residents of Pine Lakes and Lake Fairways to come and join us on Monday evenings at 6:30 pm to play some Poker with us in the Activity Room in the Clubhouse. The game starts at 7:00pm and ends around 9:00 or 9:30. The cost is only \$12 per person and that includes the possibility to win some nice prize money. New members will need to pay a **one-time** \$5 fee to become a member and help pay for cards, chips and the royal flush jack pot, etc.

To begin with, we give you \$10,000 worth of chips to begin your game. If you are familiar with the game of hold-em, the blinds will start at \$100 and \$200 and progress upwards through the evening. If you run out of chips, we allow you to rebuy \$10,000 in chips for \$10 until we break for chip up around 8:15.

Every Monday, we give away money to the person who has the highest hand for the evening. As of this writing, we had 23 players and paid \$2 a person for a pot of \$46. We have a prize of up to \$300 to an individual who has a Royal Flush. Last week I was fortunate enough to hit it for \$235. Next week it starts to grow all over again.

We also pay out prize money to the high chip hands of the evening based on how many people attend. Rebuys money is helpful in building up the pot we pay from as well as paying at least one person for every table we fill. Last week we filled 3 Tables but with the rebuy money we paid first place \$150, 2nd place we paid \$100, 3rd place payout was \$75 and 4th place received \$50. Last week we paid out a total of \$656 including the royal jack pot.

This month on the 24th of January we will have a \$20 entry fee, 4-hour Tournament like we've had in the past and you can enter Monday evening when you come to pay with us. We look forward seeing you on Monday at 6:30 pm.
