

### HELP MAKE PINE LAKES A SAFE AND HAPPY PLACE

The season is now in full swing and Pine Lakes is bursting at the seams. When we have so many people living in this active community we need to be more careful about observing the rules especially ones that are necessary for the safety of all.

- ▶ Please obey the 20-mph speed limit. Also remember that walkers have priority, then bicycles, then golf carts and finally cars.
- ▶ Please obey all stop signs. These applies to golf carts as well as cars.
- Please do not let your most precious possession, your grandchildren, drive your golf cart unless they are at least 16 years old. We have many commercial vehicles using our streets. These vehicles are often speeding and not watching for golf carts. Inexperienced drivers cannot react as quickly as necessary in emergency situations. Also, you cannot react quickly enough many times if you have a child on your lap 'pretending' to drive.
- ▶ Please do not walk on the golf cart paths. Early morning before the golfers start to play the workers are driving as fast as possible trying to finish the maintenance before the golfers start hitting balls at them. During the day we have many non-residents playing our course. They are not watching for walkers on the course.
- ➤ Please do not drive golf carts or ride bicycles on the walking paths. These paths are narrow and meant for residents to walk leisurely around the community enjoying our beautiful scenery and glorious weather. Dodging golf carts and bicycles does not contribute to a pleasant stroll.
- ▶ Pets should not be in the recreation areas. These include the area around the clubhouse, the walking paths, and the golf course. Pets are not allowed in the clubhouse or Pub. Dogs should be walked around the perimeter of the property where waste cans are placed for your convenience when picking up after your pet;

### **DECEMBER LIAISON MEETING**

The December Liaison Meeting was held December 14 in the Living Room. We started by discussing various houses that need attention to the yard or exterior of the house.

- The owner of 52F believes he has a sink hole by the garage. Julie will follow up.
- Julie created a new Resident Complaint Form. It has been suggested that a copy of all Complaint forms be given to a representative of the respective HOA Board member.
- A concern was raised over the feeding of squirrels in the pool area. Julie installed a sign stating to refrain from feeding wild animals. Judy said she would also bring this subject up at the next HOA Board meeting.
- Julie stated that mailbox repairs should be completed within 7 days from the request.
- Pete Williams raised a concern about tree debris along the cart path between hole 14 and 15. Julie said she would follow up.
- Beverly Bynum asked who should be contacted concerning broken name signs on the lamp posts. Julie stated that the concierge should be notified.
- A question was raised concerning visitor parking. Julie stated that most driveways can park multiple cars and that there can be no parking on the grass.
- A decision was made not to communicate upcoming mosquito spraying in Pine Lakes on the Robo Call system. The reason was that spraying depends on certain weather conditions and plans are likely to change if there is a change in wind direction or other variables.
- Judy mentioned that some lawn equipment is missing from homes. The general consensus was not to leave lawn equipment left out unattended.

### **GROUNDS AND MAINTENANCE**

- Julie stated that mulch and stones will be laid by the pool and tennis courts in 2018 as budget funds are released.
- It was identified that some residents are placing their yard waste along the perimeter roads. Julie emphasized that the hurricane clean-up is now over, and any tree debris must be placed on their curb on the horticulture pick-up day.

- Julie stated that replacement lights for the bridge on hole 14 have been ordered.
- Pete stated that there was a concern that lighting outside the Pub was not adequate. Pete checked the previous night and was satisfied with the lighting.
- Pete mentioned that some street signs are bent from the storm. Julie stated that money has been requested for new street signs, but has not received any yet.

### **CLUBHOUSE**

- Julie stated that she will issue a work order to paint the clubhouse walls.
- Judy suggested that labels should be placed on clubhouse cabinets indicating the committee that is using them.
- Julie stated that the felt on the poker tables will be replaced as the budget allows.

### **POOL**

- Julie stated that the pool heaters are working and the temperature is kept between 84 to 86 degrees, adding that anything warmer than that will cause black algae to grow. Also, as far as Julie is concerned, there are no issues with the pool vacuum.
- Judy asked if the hot water in the shower at the pool was working. Julie will check.

#### **PUB**

- Julie stated that a new chef has been hired. His name is Bill Fedin.
- There have been favorable comments on the new floor. Judy requested that additional insulated panels be added to buffer the noise from the bar.
- A resident committee has been formed to advise management on desired upgrades to the Pub.
- Julie mentioned that she has ordered another fryer for the Pub.

Residents are encouraged to tell their respective board members items they would like to see on the agenda for these meetings.

You want to play golf, tennis, pickleball, horse shoes, shuffleboard, bocce, cards, or paint, embroider, quilt, exercise, square dance, line dance, or play Mah Jong, bingo, billiards, dominoes, or do Tai Chi, read, take dancing lessons, do crafts, ceramics, or go to the Pub for breakfast, lunch and dinner, and attend shows, coffee socials, pancake breakfasts, pool parties, or act in plays, sing in the chorus and at Karaoke, test your memory at Trivia, join FISH and groups like the Women's Club, the Book Club, the Entertainment Committee, the Beautification Committee or the Men's Club, etc. and etc. You have so many things to do why would you want or need to join HOAll, or PLEHOA, or FMO (whatever that is)?

STOP! WAIT! All the above-mentioned activities could disappear unless you do support HOAll or PLEHOA, or FMO (whatever that is)! These organizations are your voices in Pine Lakes and in the Florida legislature while you are out doing all the fun things mentioned above. These organizations save you many headaches, trips to the Pine Lakes office, writing to Tallahassee and save you many \$\$\$ in legal fees. These organizations are your insurance policies against attacks on your Pine Lakes lifestyle when ELS does not honor your prospectus or covenant and does not abide by Florida state law FS 723.

FMO (whatever that is) protects your rights under FS 723 and pays a lobbyist in Tallahassee, FL to alert us when bills are filed in the Legislature related to manufactured home communities. Some of these bills could change our lifestyle adversely while some bills could improve life in manufactured home communities. Our FMO lobbyist reviews the legislation, educates our representative as to their affect on manufactured home communities and provides guidance. If it weren't for FMO's backing of FS 723 in 1984 we wouldn't have legal protection specifically for manufactured home communities.

Rents, maintenance fees, pass-ons, and pass-throughs are costing more and more, communities are being sold to huge corporations, legislation is being filed that could take away our present lifestyle. Today, right now, before you do

any of the activities in the first paragraph write a check PS: Here's another activity for you: come to the FMO or phone them as I'll bet they will come and pick it up. Estate residents, when your PLEHOA was formed, all of Lakes residents, estate and leased-land residents need to write a check to FMO, Federation of Manufactured FMO at 727-530-7539 to use your credit card, or email will be thankful for your deliciousness. for membership beth@fmo.org, or call your neighbors Maura Alexander 239-543-9642 and Linda Dowd 239-789-6626 for an application for FMO membership (now that you know what it is), they will bring the application right to your door or mail tube.

When you've joined these critical organizations to keep your retirement secure, go and enjoy all that beautiful Pine Lakes has to offer. I'm really not sorry if I bothered you and just so you know, with your memberships we'll have Manufactured- homeowners-people-power to overcome ELS-money-power. Thank you.

He reminded everyone to check on the Pub's hours during the holidays. The annual meeting will be held on Monday February 12th. We have two board positions open and only two candidates running. He would like to see more running to give the members a choice.

### Resident concerns:

1. Street signs still need to be repaired. Some are bent and some are difficult to read.

- 2. There has been an issue with people stealing equipment from yards when landscapers go to the horticulture area to dump brush. Also people are dumping garbage in the horticulture area.
- 3. A resident was concerned it is dark in front of the Pub and suggested they add another light.
- 4. Some brush was pushed off the road and into the woods after the hurricane. He would like to see this removed.

Our next meeting will be held on Wednesday January 10th at 7:00 PM in the living room.

With no further business to conduct, a motion was made and President Williams adjourned the meeting at 7:35 pm.

### PINE LAKES BILLIARDS

appy New Year 2018 to all Pine Lakes residents!!

This article concerns Pine Lakes Pool.....meaning games played with a cue on a table with pockets – no swimming involved.

I was recently elected by Pine Lakes' pool players as their Pine Lakes Billiard's Liaison. This is my first article for Whispering Pines. In this role, I'll be frequently submitting articles with information about pool activities occurring throughout the Pine Lakes community. Being lovers of the cue sports, our group would like to increase interest and enthusiasm for the sport among our residents. These articles will be of special interest to those individuals that would like to get back playing pool or those that have always wanted to start playing but have been hesitant.

As most of you probably know, there are two pool tables with "house" cues located in the north end of the Pine Lakes Clubhouse next to the craft room. The pool tables aren't being thoroughly utilized. Mainly, they are being used by the organized Pine Lakes Billiards' teams as part of a multicommunity 8-ball league on Tuesday/Thursday evenings. Those tables' availability presents ample opportunity for Pine Lakes' residents to join in the fun that playing pool offers. Perhaps you'd like to increase your social contacts, want competitive activities in your weekly routine or just want to increase your general level of activity. Walking around pool tables can be suitable exercise versus sitting around the house.

There are many ways of becoming involved in the sport depending on your desires. If sufficient interest is expressed, a Pine Lakes Pool League for competition within Pine Lakes could be organized something like what Debbie Hamilton did in past years. Or, perhaps you'd like to learn how to play pool. Maybe creating open play opportunities with scheduled pool playing sessions several days each week. Another way of becoming involved is for individuals to form a third Pine Lakes' team that would participate in weekly competition along with the two existing Pine Lakes' teams. This requires at least five individuals to express an interest in forming this third team. If being a full-time team member isn't of interest to you perhaps adding your name to a substitute player list would better fit your wishes. Also, pool is not just a man's sport. Therefore, ladies that would enjoy playing pool are also encouraged to respond. (FYI, there are many women playing professional and

amateur pool and Heron's Glen has had a couple of ladies on their roster in previous seasons.) Any of the mentioned suggestions would be a great way to pursue your interests in playing pool. Just let us know about your interests and desires. Come join the challenging and rewarding fun.

See the instructions and contacts at the end of this article for sharing your pool interests, desires, thoughts and suggestions with the group. After processing and correlating submitted feedback, we'll be planning activities for those wanting to get involved in playing pool which we hope will have broad appeal. Watch for published announcements or being directly contacted about future pool activities.

There has been organized billiards in Pine Lakes for at least the past 10 years. Debbie Hamilton had a group of golfers joining her for pool on Fridays that's not active for this season. Also, The North Fort Myers Seniors 8-Ball League (the "League") was created years ago through the joint efforts of Bill Hercek (Pine Lakes) and Harry Christopher (Del Tura) to commence 8-Ball competition among communities in North Fort Myers. Currently, Pine Lake residents Al Solvang is Director of the League and Rich Pietkun is Assistant Director. There are 12 teams participating in the League representing the following communities: Pine Lakes, Lake Fairways, Herons Glen, Del Tura, Tamiami Village, Horizon, Six Lakes, Buccaneer and Pioneer Village. Play is on Tuesdays and some Thursdays at the various communities with each visiting 5-person team playing the home 5-person team. Players of all skill levels are playing. There are 88 players on the League's roster of which 35% are rated at 40 or higher (as of December 15th). The ratings are based upon weekly average points scored. A perfect score is 50 for each player's weekly matches. There will be end of season tournaments to determine overall winners of the League in each category.

Representing Pines Lakes in the League are two teams: Pine Lakes 1 is captained by Rich Pietkun and Pine Lakes 2 is captained by Tony Fettig. The Pine Lakes 1 team in 1st place and the Pine Lakes 2 team is in 6th place among the 12 teams after 3 weeks of play. Obviously, Pine Lakes 1 has very skillful players and they have won the league championship many times. For the second half of this year there will be two skill categories, A & B

scored in the League to increase competitiveness of likeskilled teams. The top 6 teams will be in the A category and bottom 6 teams will be in the B category.

In other pool related news, a request has been submitted by Johnny Graverson, the former Pine Lakes Billiards Liaison, to ELS for refurnishing the pool room with appropriate furniture. Both Judy Hale, on behalf of the PLHOAII, and Pete Williams, on behalf of the PLEHOA, have approved the request. Presently, there are card tables and "hand-medown" chairs/stools, none of which are customary pool room furniture. Having the proper furniture improves the full functioning and attractiveness of the pool room and brings it up to par with other communities' pool room facilities.

Finally, we would greatly appreciate you submitting your interests, desires, thoughts, and suggestions for broadening pool activities for yourself and all residents of Pine Lakes.
