1. Card Room tables and chairs in need of updating

We have already closed out submissions for budget concerns 2026. I can investigate this, search for a vendor or supplier and obtain quotes nut it is highly unlikely I will be able to get it approved for 2025/26.

Would folding tables be acceptable? Ron to investigate for Men's Club assistance.

2. Clubhouse downspout needs to be reconnected -

We have a vendor pricing this out along with a few other key items for repair.

3. Pickleball court gravel resolution -

Replacement is part of a greater concrete cap x project; however, Bob is going to give pavers a try- hopefully get started on that within the next week.

Sandy is also looking into the light for the pickleball courts.

4. Condition of the Lakes – status

The "gunk" is the dead grass and weeds that have been treated every 14 days and will naturally drop to the bottom of the lake naturally as intended. Four months of poor service will still take a little bit longer to get to the lakes where we expect them to be.

Vendor has been onsite; lakes were neglected for several months; they are correcting.

5. Weeds at storage -

6. Key for evacuation gate in Lake Fairways –

I will submit a work order to see what needs to be done.

8. Request Pool deck be pressure washed –

Yes, that will be scheduled soon. We have a project request to resurface the pool, I was hoping to wait to see if I can get that approved first.

9. Sign Spinner at PL? -

No plan for a sign spinner at PL. The sales center for both communities is located at Lake Fairways which is why it was stationed at that corner.

10. Brush cut back request at the bridge to LF-

I will place a work order to address providing a clearer view of oncoming vehicles.
