



North Fort Myers Fire Department has instituted a new safety procedure to identify residents who need assistance after a mandatory evacuation notice has been issued. If you are evacuating, please display the OK side of the sign in a front door or window. If you are staying in place, please complete and deposit (at the gate) a non-evacuating form (on page 28 of this issue) and display the HOME side of the sign in your window. After the event and you are OK, flip the sign to OK. Rescue personal will be able to quickly identify those who need immediate help. We all hope that every home will be able to have the OK sign displayed after the storm. SIGNS WILL BE AVAILABLE IN THE PINE LAKES CLUBHOUSE. ONE PER HOUSEHOLD PLEASE.




In closing, we will keep you all informed as best we can about anything going on in our community. Looking forward to seeing all of you folks back here soon and safe travels.



A moment of silence is observed at 8:46 a.m. (EDT), signifying the exact time that American Airlines Flight 11 struck the North Tower of the World Trade Center.

18 September: Air Force Birthday (1947)

<u>Third Friday in September: POW/MIA Recognition Day</u> The third Friday in September is a day of remembrance for all those who have been deemed Missing In Action and / or a Prisoner of War. Countless families have been forced to bear the heartbreak of not knowing what happened to their soldiers. May we never forget the sacrifices made on our behalf, that we may live in freedom.

24 Last Sunday in September: Gold Star Mother's and Family's Day -In 1928 Grace Darling Seibold set out on a journey to find out what happened to her son in World War I. She worked in veteran's hospitals in hopes of finding him. Instead, she found many more, who like her, were longing to know what had happened to their soldiers. A support network was formed. Eventually Mrs. Seibold learned of her son's death and another support group grew out of the need to grieve the fallen together. This group became the American Gold Star Mothers. The American Gold Star Mothers work tirelessly to provide the necessary support to those who join their ranks. They also function as a service organization in order to continue their family's service to our country and to honor those who gave their lives for it.







C.E.R.T. AND SAFETY....continued

When a Mandatory Evacuation Order has been issued by Florida State officials manufactured homes (Pine Lakes) are to evacuate. The Mandatory Evacuation Order is usually ordered when high winds are expected as with a hurricane, tornado, or a storm surge. Our solution is to have residents who choose to stay in place complete a short form (sample below) that can be obtained at the Gate House or concierge desk and deposit it in the Emergency Evacuation Box located on the exit side of the Gate House wall. This information may be used by First Responders to expedite rescue response time after a disaster. Please plan ahead. If mandatory evacuation is ordered, complete and deposit the form as soon as you make your decision to stay.
